Hi Everyone,

We would like to thank everyone for their patience. Under the current COVID-19 Public Health measures set out by the government of Ontario, the campground is permitted to open for those with a full season contract. The campground will open at 9am Friday May 7, 2021. Please keep in mind that there is currently a Stay-at-Home Order in place, so if you plan to come to the campground, it should be for essential reasons only. **Please come prepared so that you don't have to travel to town or our surrounding area to get things that you need. With the stay at home order still in place, if you choose to come to the campground, you should be staying in the campground.**

Store hours for May are Friday 3-8pm, Saturday 9am-5pm, and Sunday 9am-1pm. If you need to arrive outside of store hours without paperwork and payment completed, please make an appointment with us.

Please see below for the current COVID-19 restrictions at the campground. We will notify you by email when there are changes to any of these restrictions. Or you can find them at any time posted on the homepage of our website.

#### **Visitors**

Until further notice, only those listed on your Seasonal Contract (immediate family who live in the same household as you) will be permitted in the campground. No additional adults/families or outside visitors are permitted at this time.

#### **Common Areas and Facilities**

All common areas and facilities in the campground are currently closed. This includes public washrooms, laundry facilities, pool, hall, pavilion, playgrounds, horseshoes, shuffleboard, basketball, and all other recreational areas.

#### **Limit of People on a Campsite/ Gatherings**

Under the current guidelines, outdoor gatherings of any size are not permitted, except with members of your own household. This means that **visiting other people on campsites or roadways is not permitted.**

#### **Store**

The store is open for window pickup only. Please remember to obey physical distancing rules if there is a line-up. Masks are mandatory for window pickup and while waiting in line at the store.

**Please do not come to the campground if you, or anyone in your family:**

1) Have one or more of the following COVID-19 symptoms:

- fever and/or chills
- cough or barking cough (croup)
- shortness of breath
- sore throat
- difficulty swallowing
- decrease or loss of smell or taste
- runny or stuffy/congested nose

- headache
- nausea/vomiting or diarrhea
- muscle aches
- extreme tiredness

2) Are currently experiencing any new COVID-19 symptoms and/or waiting for test results after experiencing symptoms

3) Have travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days

4) Have been identified as a “close contact” of someone who currently has COVID-19 in the past 14 days

5) Have been told by a doctor, health care provider, or public health unit that you should currently be isolating (staying at home)

6) Have received a COVID Alert exposure notification on your cell phone in the past 14 days

Please keep in mind that these measures are in place to protect all of our campers and staff. Anyone found not adhering to them will be asked to leave and their seasonal contract may be terminated. Thank you in advance for your cooperation. We are looking forward to another safe, enjoyable season!
